## BY-LAW NO. 332 -1999

## A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF A MAXIMUM OF ONE METRE OF SIDEWALK ADJACENT TO AND FOR THE LENGTH OF THEIR STOREFRONT BY ALL BUSINESSES IN PICTON

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 210 (73) of the Municipal Act, Chapter M.45, R.S.O. 1990 the Council of a local municipality may pass by-laws regulating sales by retail in the highways under its jurisdiction;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward deems it expedient to permit the use of a portion of sidewalk for the use of adjacent businesses for retail sales subject to certain limitations;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT all businesses in the Ward of Picton are permitted to use half of the width of the sidewalk, up to a maximum of one metre, adjacent to and for the length of their storefront for retail sales.
- 2. THAT the use of sidewalk space along the curb is prohibited.
- 3. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and liable, upon conviction, to a fine or penalty as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990 Chapter P.33.
- 4. The provisions of this by-law shall come into force and effect on the day of final passing thereof.

Read a first, second, and third time and finally passed this  $21^{st}$  day of December, 1999.
